RAISING FUNDS FOR CHROMEBOOKS FOR SCHOOLS

Since March last year, our Rotary members have been donating the money they would have spent on Rotary lunches into a pool that has helped over seven local charities, most notably the York Foodbank, with over £25,000 donated so far.

In January, in conjunction with the other two Rotary Clubs in York we have been raising money for six local schools to buy Chromebook laptops that the schools can then lend out to disadvantaged children, enabling them to keep up with their studies during lockdown. Our own club - supporting York High School and Fulford School - has raised over £3200 so far.
